



New GLP-1 Bridge Program

CMS launched the Medicare GLP-1 Bridge Program on July 1, expanding coverage of GLP-1 medications — including Foundayo, Wegovy (the injection and tablets), and Zepbound KwikPen — to eligible Medicare beneficiaries with Part D for weight loss.

The GLP-1 Bridge Program operates outside of the Medicare Part D plan and utilizes a central processor to manage prior authorizations and claims processing set up by CMS. **This means the prescription should not be sent to the patient’s Medicare Advantage plan. Any prescription sent to HealthTeam Advantage under the GLP-1 Bridge Program will be denied.**

If a prescriber is writing for a GLP-1 medication to be covered via the GLP-1 Bridge Program, when transmitting the prescription to the pharmacy, the prescriber should include “Send to Bridge for weight management” on the prescription.
